26 Oct 2019 was the 53rd anniversary of the Oriskany fire: SAD

Message from Chibbaro, Anthony (O' Ships Company) WARRIORTC@msn.com

From Tony C, who was ships company but roomed with Saint pilot, Ron Tardio, who perished in the fire:

To the gym today wearing a 'Navy' tee shirt - tomorrow will go to the gym wearing an Oriskany tee shirt - in memory and honor of our 44 fellow officers and sailors who died in the Oriskany fire on 26 October 1966.

At 2330 hours on this date - 25 October 1966 - I reported to the bridge for a 'midnight watch' - it was in addition to my 12 watches in Communications - **Cdr Juntilla**, CIC Officer, had advised me that it would help me getting transferred to CIC if I started standing some bridge watches . . I'd been CIC Officer on a DER out of OCS and wanted to transfer to CIC.

Standing that watch probably saved my life as I'd had some 2+ hours of sleep when I heard the first alarm - "this is a drill, fire, fire" - I turned over in my bunk to go back to sleep.

<u>Saint Ron Tardio</u>, who had the bunk below mine, pulled my curtain; shook me awake, and told me "Tony, it's really bad you have to get up" before I could say a word to Ron, he did what I would have done IF I'd gotten up quickly - ran aft, and I too, would have died of smoke inhalation like Ron.

Lynn Bentley and I were the last two guys out of the 01 Junior Officers Bunk Room - Lynn remembers the name of the officer who was at the hatch in the passageway leading out of the bunk room, who told us that we couldn't go

aft, that we had to go forward, which we did - through the hatch leading to the area where the anchor chains are stored. There were flames on the other side of the hatch after we closed it.

I am sure ALL have their own memories and stories of that fateful day.

No matter what adversities, failures, heartaches and heart breaks I've suffered these past 53 years - I am damn thankful to be alive - I very often wear a Navy or Oriskany tee shirt to the gym - a reminder to be so thankful for the years since the fire.

A side note - 7 years ago on a trip to NJ to visit family I went to visit the NJ Vietnam War Veterans Museum and Memorial Wall. It is a nice museum. To go to the round 'wall' with some 1700+ names one has to go up steps - there were about 8 sets of steps. I wanted to look up **Frank Tunick's** name; had no idea where it was on the wall - just went up a flight of steps, went to the wall - and - stood right in front of Frank's name. When I mentioned what had happened to the woman at the front desk of the museum - she smiled and told me - "that happens a lot".

Message from Bill Tomko about his Sailor grandson and Carriers Info: 12 month deployments.....

Dear family and friends, I wanted to share the latest on Sailor Grandson Collin since many have asked to be kept informed. My Latest call from Collin yesterday who is Very Excited and ready to GO and use his training and skills to do what he enlisted to do. Finally He said they will be leaving/deploying Nov.18 to relieve the USS Eisenhower from the Arabian Sea duty (Monitoring Iran) after the USS IKE awaited another Carrier to relieve them after their extended 11 month deployment delays which should have been only 7 to 8 months due to numerous Carriers (8 at one point in time) were under Planned Maintenance/Nuke refueling and or associated problems adding to the Carrier fleets unavailability. Such as the USS Truman's electrical power failures and associated months of delays. That Carrier replacement shortage elongated The Abe Lincoln's return 3 to 4 months (I feel sorry for their Family members awaiting them) Collin will be shoving off leaving Naval Station Norfolk,VA for his first adventure at sea working on the flight deck moving, starting aircraft and depending on specific assignment T0 be determined job working with the Catapult crew and or arresting gear crew most likely. They will hope to be back in the US 5 or 6 months if all goes well on scheduled deployment relieved by the USS Eisenhower. May they be Blessed with Calm Sea's fair skies and the wind at his back. And to the Bad guys of Iran" Give them Hell Harry!!! Go Speed Collin and Crew and keep them safe. Proud Navy Grandpa Bill


